



St. John's Regional Office (Elaine Dobbins Centre for Autism): A Social Story



**Today I am going to the Elaine Dobbin
Centre for Autism.**



**I will enter the building through this door
and go inside the porch.**



This is the main lobby. I might see staff and other people walking around.



This door leads to The Pantry Café. I can buy myself a snack and drink if I want.



Inside The Pantry Café, I can order at the counter or wait for a table to sit at.



If I need help finding where I need to go, I can ask the receptionist at this desk.



**I might be asked to go to the welcome
room.**



This is the welcome room. I can relax in here while I wait for staff to come get me.



If I need to use the bathroom there is one in the main lobby. It is gender neutral and has an accessible button.



To go to the second floor I can use the
stairs or the **elevator**.



These are the stairs I will use.



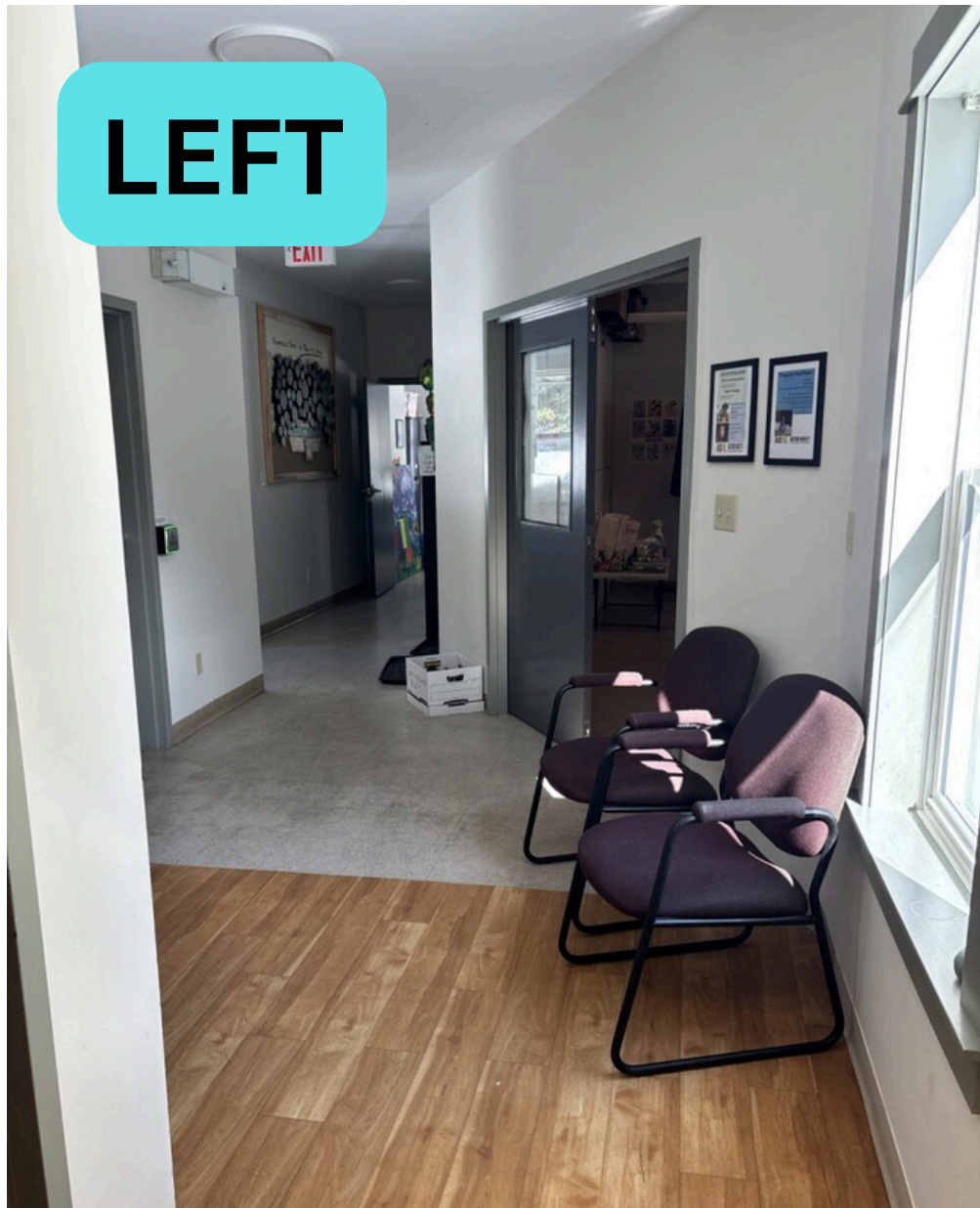
**When I reach the top of the stairs I will
see this door.**



If I use the elevator, I will go through this door to get to the second floor.



**I will come out through this door on the
second floor.**

Once I am on the second floor I can go
left or **right**



If I turn **right** down the hall, I can go to the connection room.



The connection room might look different depending on what programs are happening today.



I may also use the connection room as a quiet space when participating in other programs.



If I go further down the **right** hall there is a bathroom.



I can use this bathroom if I need to.



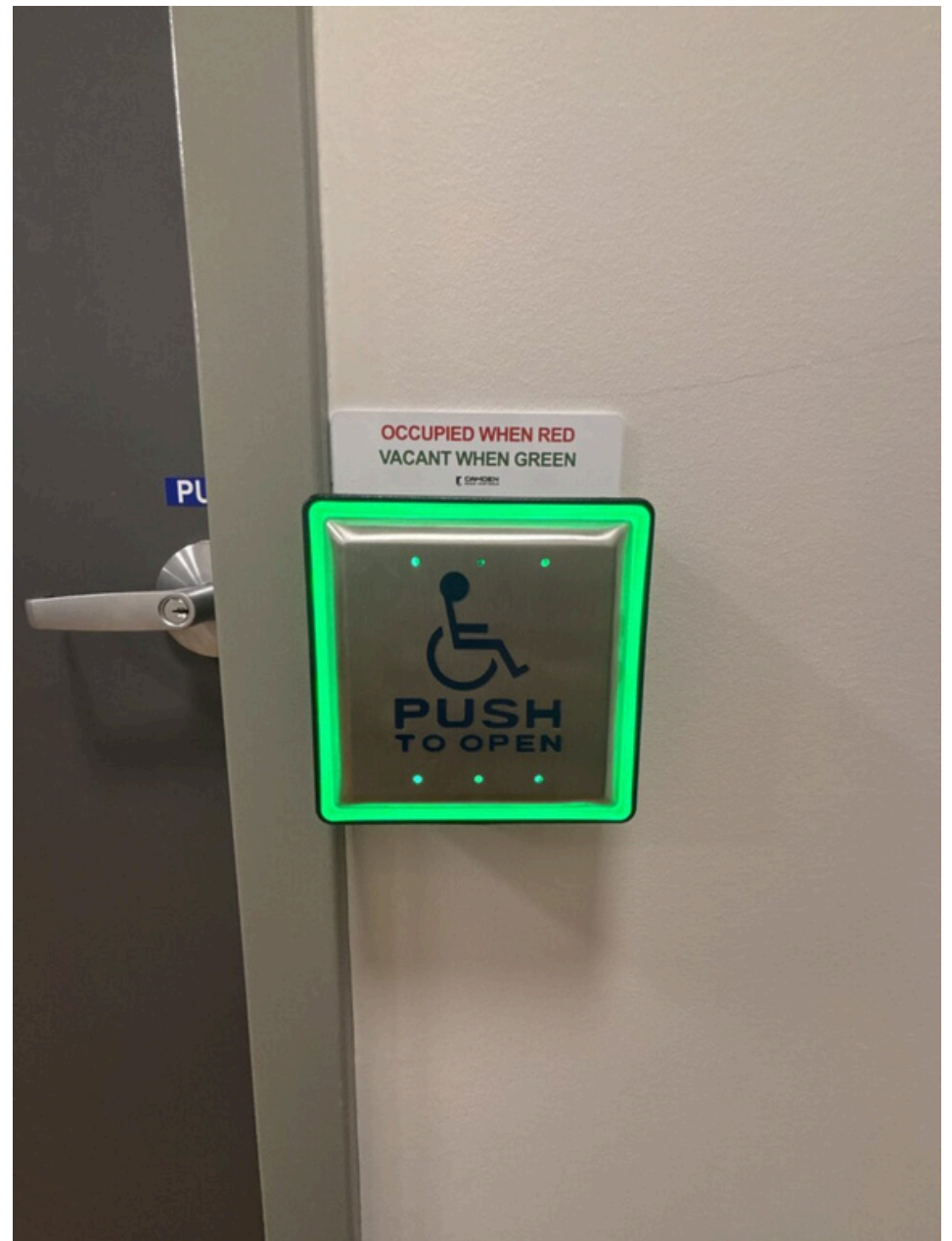
If I go **left** from the stairs/elevator, I will see the multipurpose room.



It may look different inside the multipurpose room depending on what programs are going on.



The multipurpose room may have tables or other equipment laid out.



By the multipurpose room there is an accessible bathroom.



I can use this bathroom if I need to. The buttons will open/close the door and lock it.



I will see doors with whiteboards on them throughout the building. These are staff offices.



**The whiteboards will tell me if the staff
inside are busy.**
